

1.	Question:	<i>Can we begin our data entry for 2012-2013?</i>
	Answer:	Yes, the system became available on Monday, October 15, 2012.
	Status:	Closed
2.	Question:	<i>I already did my program exits for 2011-2012. Since we no longer need to have a forced exit at the end of the program year if a participant returns, how do we 'un-exit' those already exited?</i>
	Answer:	If a program exit has already been processed for 2011-2012 and the participant returned this year, you will simply need to re-register the participant for 2012-2013. Going forward, if a participant plans to return the next year, you do not need to force a program exit.

3.	Question:	<i>When setting up classes for 2012-2013, I am asked for the amount of the funding for the class. Last year we entered zeros. Is it the same for this year?</i>
	Answer:	Yes, you will still enter zeros for the class funding amount.

4.	Question:	<i>I am trying to copy a class with participants into the 2012-2013 program year. However the participants are not copying over into the new class.</i>
	Answer:	There are 3 pieces of criteria to copy a class with participants: 1) The participants to be copied with the class must be active in the class as of June 30, 2012 and cannot be exited from this 11/12 class 2) Attendance for the participants must be up to date through May, 2012 3) Participants must have a 12/13 pre-test entered. Once these 3 criteria for each participant is completed, then the class can be copied with all eligible participants. Be sure to review Chapter 4; Class Copy Functions of the MAERS 2.1 User Manual.
